Greetings and Grace and Peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ,

I must apologize for the difficulty we had with the Zoom platform yesterday. I did go ahead and record the service and it will be posted on the slvumc.org and on our website www.umcofcenter.com. Thank you to those who tried to join our 8:30 am Zoom worship and to all who came to our 10:30 am Drive-In service. We had several new folks join us for the drive-in service. It is such a joy to see you every time we worship. (For now, we gather for worship via 8:30 am Zoom and 10:30 am Drive-In Worship on the front steps of Center United Methodist Church to celebrate this wonderful day. The drive-in service follows the COVID-19 guidelines including distancing. Bulletins were slipped through the window as well as emailed before Sunday. The church is not open which means, unfortunately, the restrooms are not open.) If you are vulnerable or feel ill next Sunday, as much as we would love to see you, please remain at home and join us for the Zoom worship. It is my prayer that all of you do what you feel is necessary for maintaining your health and protecting yourself.

We will continue the 8:30 am Zoom worship as joint Center and Saguache church group for those who are not able to join us physically or who are vulnerable to COVID-19. On June 14, 2020, the Center church will begin our reopening process. We will follow the COVID-19 updated guidelines which may change as we move closer to the reopening date. Right now those restrictions require 25 people or less in each room wearing masks and maintaining social distancing. According to the state and county guidelines, a family unit can count for 1 person and do not need separate. Non-touch temperatures will be taken and anyone with fever will not be able to enter. Restrooms will be available but with posted restrictions to follow. Unfortunately coffee and fellowship can't occur at this time, but you are welcome to bring your coffee or drink in your container. Again, if you do not feel safe or you do not wish to follow the precautions or if you do not feel well, please join via Zoom and we will look forward to gathering together when we don't have to follow so many of these precautions and it's safe.

If you wish to participate in our virtual service via phone or computer, Zoom worship will occur at 8:30 am. The church will open at 6:30 pm so that we can follow the safety protocols and there will be an overflow area once we have met the seating limit for the sanctuary.

There are plans for Church in the Wildwood at Beaver Creek to occur June 7th and the camp is planning to open for campers July 1st. Of course, Church in the Wildwood is contingent on whether the governing authorities allow Beaver Creek to open up. We were able to give Center Food Bank ten bags of meals and toiletries to be used with workers in quarantine. We are still collecting protein items which can be canned meat or frozen one-pound package of meat that can be dropped off to Linda Clutter at Tommy's Plumbing from 8-noon and 1-5 Monday through Friday. She will get them to our local food bank as the donations come in.

Our Mountain Sky Annual Conference will be held digitally June 19-20. Since there is no travel involved which has caused us not to be represented at annual conferences in the past by laity, this would allow us to have voting representation from our laity for this annual conference.
